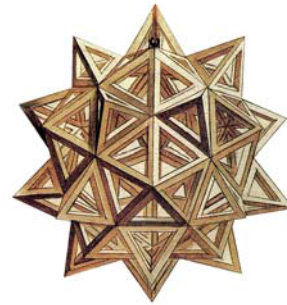

Dear parents,

The math teachers have prepared summer homework problems that will help your children preserve the knowledge they have acquired over the past year and start the new academic year fully prepared.

If your child has received a final math grade of 85 or higher, the homework problems are optional. But if the math grade is lower, and the teacher has asked the student to do the problems, they are strongly encouraged to do so. In addition, those students who received a letter from the teacher indicating that the summer homework problems are **required** must bring the completed assignment to school no later than September 1, 2014.

If a student has previously received a summer assignment handout from the teacher, he or she can choose whether to complete the handout assignment or the assignment downloaded from the website (only one of the two needs to be completed).
